The book will challenge young readers to imagine working with and caring for animals.

The presentation of facts and figures regarding dairy cattle of various breeds is highly educational. As I looked at some of the facts about the countries of origin of the seven breeds, I envisioned discussions about these countries and their locations in the world, particularly in Western Europe.

Carolyn's background in farming allows her to write with agricultural experience using her typical energy, enthusiasm, and excellence. No words are wasted because they are all so carefully chosen. The watercolour illustrations by Richard McNaughton are also top class!

Jack and Clover is a wonderful bridge-building book for both the farming community and those who are also part of agriculture, in that they eat every day.
